

NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION CASWELL COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

The statewide primary election will be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2024.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day at your regular polling location.

Early Voting: at the following location from Thursday, February 15, 2024, to Saturday, March 2, 2024:

- County Board of Elections office, 140 Main Street, Yanceyville, NC. Early Voting Hours are Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. – 7:30 p.m. and Saturday, March 2, 2024 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Absentee voting by-mail: Voters must complete and return an absentee request form (available on the State Board of Elections website or county board of elections office). Once the request form is received and approved your ballot will be mailed to you. Absentee voting requires the voter to sign and complete the back of the return envelope that must be witnessed by two qualified persons or a notary public. You are required to place a copy of an eligible photo ID in the clear sleeve on the back of your return ballot envelope. Completed absentee ballots must be mailed or returned to the Caswell County Board of Elections by Tuesday, March 5, 2024 7:30 PM.

Voters voting in person are entitled to assistance by an election official, or, if assistance is needed due to disability, by a qualified person of their choice. Voters must state they need assistance and designate who assists them. Curbside voting is available for voters who are not able to physically enter voting sites due to disability.

In the primary election, voters will select nominees for a political party to move on to the 2024 General Election in November. The Caswell County Board of Education seats will be elected in the primary and not move forward to the General Election.

Contests in the Primary Election: Presidential Preference, U.S. House of Representatives, N.C. Governor, NC Lt. Governor, NC Attorney General, NC Auditor, NC Commissioner of Agriculture, NC Commissioner of Insurance, NC Commissioner of Labor, NC Secretary of State, NC Superintendent of Public Instruction, NC Treasurer, NC Supreme Court Associate Justice, NC Court of Appeals Judge, Caswell County Board of Commissioners and Caswell County Board of Education.

Unaffiliated voters may choose the ballot of candidates for any party primary. In the event of a second primary you would be required to vote the same party chosen for this primary election.

The voter registration deadline for this election is 5 p.m. Friday, February 9, 2024. Eligible individuals who are not registered by that deadline may register and vote at the early voting site during the early voting period and will be required to show a photo ID. Voters who wish to change party affiliation must do so by the February 9th deadline.
